RED LIGHT NEW MUSIC, the enterprising composer collective and new music ensemble, announces its 2011/12 concert season, featuring three mainstage performances at New York City's pre-eminent multi-disciplinary performing arts center, PETER NORTON SYMPHONY SPACE'S LEONARD NIMOY THALIA.

In this, it's seventh season, Red Light New Music builds on a recent slate of deftly irreverent, illuminating concerts, with programs exploring themes of environmental influence, musical influence and the influence of collaboration on the creative process.

The season begins with **IN A LANDSCAPE: MUSIC AS A MAP** (8pm, Monday, October 3, 2011), a program featuring **JOHN LUTHER ADAMS's The Light Within** and the NYC premiere of **CHAYA CZERNOWIN's Lovesong**, paired with world premieres by Red Light composers **VINCENT RAIKHEL** and **CHRISTOPHER CERRONE**. Luther Adams's *The Light Within* meditates on the ecstatic joy of watching the flow of time and light in the vast sky; Raikhel's *cryovolcano* embodies the changing face of glaciers in our time and place; Cerrone's *Wall Pieces* examines the vibrations of the nocturnal urban map; and Czernowin's *Lovesong* delves into the intimate landscape of the human heart in love. The union of these works brings forth a dialogue exploring spaces real and imagined, and relationships of era and time. RICHARD CARRICK, composer and cofounder/director of Either/Or, will moderate a preconcert discussion with the Red Light directors about the program.

The second program, **THE VIOLA IN MY LIFE: THE INFLUENCE OF MORTON FELDMAN** (8pm, Monday, February 27, 2012) examines the active influence of Morton Feldman's unique voice and body of work on a dramatic breadth of musicians and composers, embodied here with works by **TED HEARNE** (who is also Red Light's Resident Conductor,) **KEERIL MAKAN** and Red Light director **SCOTT WOLLSCHLEGER**. Each of these composers finds resonance and inspiration in Feldman's body of work in wholly unique and surprising ways, with voices which are perhaps not readily apparent as descendents of Feldman's. Red Light violist **ERIN WIGHT** frames the dialogue with Feldman's *The Viola in My Life I* and *II*. Composer NILS VIGELAND, a former student of Feldman's, will moderate a pre-concert discussion with the composers.

Red Light's third and final program of the season, **METROPOLIS: A LIVE SCORE** (8pm Monday, May 21, 2012) presents a new collaborative score to FRITZ LANG's 1927 German Expressionist masterpiece, METROPOLIS. To create a rich, fluid score for this vibrant silent film, screened here in the Kino International's restored version, Red Light brings together a community of composers, including Red Light directors

VINCENT RAIKHEL, **SCOTT WOLLSCHLEGER**, **CHRISTOPHER CERRONE** and **LIAM ROBINSON**, with **ADRIAN KNIGHT**, **BOB PIERZAK** and **KYLE HILLBRAND**. In a development of the practice of group composition Red Light employed with last season's wildly popular presentation of *The Cabinet of Doctor Caligari*, this project will present a truly integrated score, overseen by Vincent Raikhel, and worked on by all composers together. The result will be something fully incorporated, not a pastiche, but a complete work giving active voice to the film's deeply human story.

With its range of commissions, world premieres, thematic exploration and collaborative projects, Red Light New Music's 2011/12 season promises to be compelling, surprising and not-to-be-missed.

Composer collective and new music ensemble **RED LIGHT NEW MUSIC** is an essential and unique voice in the vibrant New York City new music scene and beyond. Created in 2004 at the Manhattan School of Music, and led by composers **Vincent Raikhel**, **Scott Wollschleger**, **Christopher Cerrone**, and **Liam Robinson**, with a crew of top-notch, adventuresome musicians, Red Light New Music has won a devoted audience and widespread critical acclaim for its excellent performances, remarkable collaborations, and deftly irreverent programming.

Recent highlights include sold-out performances of Christopher Cerrone's opera in one act, *Invisible Cities*; a presentation of Mauricio Kagel's *Eine Brise* for 111 cyclists; an acclaimed presentation of a collaborated live score to the 1920 German Expressionist horror film, *The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari*; and a 10/11 season-opening concert including a three-composer reenvisioning of Mozart's Piano Concerto No. 9 with RLNM pianist Yegor Shevtsov.

Red Light has brought its illuminating programs to New York City's (le) Poisson Rouge, the Galapagos Art Space, The Stone, the Italian Academy at Columbia University, and the Chelsea Art Museum; to the Kennedy Center and the Phillips Collection in Washington, DC; and further a field to the Hochschule für Musik Hanns Eisler Berlin, the wulf in Los Angeles, as well as week-long residencies at the University of California, San Diego and the Usinesonore Festival in Switzerland.
